

Safety Rails

Q. Can safety rails be used on ArjoHuntleigh systems?

A. ArjoHuntleigh recommends the use of safety rails on the bed when using their dynamic, active or static systems. Local facility policies regarding the use of safety rails should also be taken into account and their use considered in light of an individual risk assessment. Each facility should assess the fit of the device to the bed frame and side rails to ensure minimum risk of entrapment.

Note: that the side rails are used to indicate the edge of the bed and not to constrain or retain a confused or restless patient.
